Location/Programme Options: The Irish College of English has been running Youth Programmes for over 15 years and has an International reputation for quality programmes. We run our junior programme in two locations in Dublin – Malahide & Swords. Each Branch offers a friendly small school atmosphere with a unique and varied programme to suit different learners. In addition to English language tuition, we offer students a range of cultural and recreational activities. These include trips to Guinness Storehouse, Trinity College, Kilmainham Gaol, sports, cinema etc.

Tuition: There is a maximum of 15 students in our mixed nationality classes. Students are tested on arrival and placed into the appropriate level class. On completion of their course students are given a certificate of attainment. In addition, all students receive their own text book and additional course materials. Teaching Methodology is communicative. Students are encouraged to improve their fluency and work on all aspects of the Language. Our focus is on student progression and teachers encourage students to immerse themselves in the language.

Host Family Accommodation: Students stay with carefully selected families within walking distance or a short bus journey (10mins) from the school. We receive excellent feedback on our host families and pride ourselves on offering a quality service.

Sailing Programme more detailed information

Location

Fingal Sailing School is located on Malahide Estuary and is only a 10 minute walk from The Irish College of English. The estuary itself is a perfect place to learn any of these activities as its quite sheltered and the water is not excessively deep - most adults and teenagers are never out of their dept.

Programme	Participants are divided into groups of 12 and have their own instructor. Each afternoon will include 3 hours of multi activity sailing.
Levels	All levels of rider can be catered for from total beginner to advanced.
Equipment	Equipment is provided by the centre as follows : wetsuit, buoyancy aid & all other equipment needed to get on the water. All the students need to bring with them swimwear, a towel and an old pair of sports runners.
Insurance	While Fingal Sailing School are fully insured, all students must have full personal insurance and check with your provider that watersports and sailing are covered. Sailing is a risk sport your choice to sail is voluntary.
Lessons	All instructors are Qualified ISA (Irish Sailing Association) instructors. They are at students sides offering tips and encouragement throughout the session. Once students gain confidence and are in control they can venture out to the middle of the estuary which has more challenging conditions.
